



TOWN OF DENMARK, MAINE REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL PAVING BIDS

The Town of Denmark is accepting written proposals from qualified Bidders for Spring 2026 Road Paving. This includes furnishing all labor, equipment and materials required to satisfactorily and safely conduct all work. The Town reserves the right to accept or reject any or all proposals in whole or in part and to waive any informality the Town may determine necessary. The Town also reserves to itself the exclusive right to accept any proposals when it is deemed by the Town to be in its best interest. The Town is governed by Title 1 M.R.S.A. § 408-A, the Freedom of Access Law, which treats Bid Specifications as public documents. In awarding any proposal, the Town may consider, but not be limited to, any of the following factors: bidder qualifications, price, experience, solvency, financial standing with the Town, history of claims with the Town, history of work quality with the Town, warranties, references, insurance bonding, compliance record, safety record, delivery date, work schedule, and past and present service of Bidder.

Scope of Work: Paving approximately 1.3 miles of roadway. For a detailed Scope of Work, please email the Public Works Director or go to the Town of Denmark Website under Public Announcements.

Paving is to be completed to the satisfaction of the Town no later than June 30, 2026

Sealed bids labeled "Road Paving 2026" will be accepted at the Denmark Town Office, until 4:00 pm, Monday, April 27, 2026.

Bids will be opened at the Select Board Meeting April 28, 2026.

ROAD PAVING 2026

REQUEST FOR BID PROPOSAL

The Town of Denmark is seeking Bid Proposals for the following paving project(s) to be performed in the Spring of 2026. All work shall be completed by June 30, 2026.

The project consists of approximately 1.3 miles of roadway. Final quantities may be adjusted based on budgetary considerations.

SCOPE OF WORK

- Bush Row Road
- Approximate Length: 1.3 miles
- Pavement Width: 21ft minimum.
- Location: Starting at new joint (as field marked).
- Material: Overlay of 1.5", 12 mm after compaction of overlay hot mix asphalt material.

Specifications:

- Contractor shall sweep and prepare road surface for paving.
- Tack coating shall be applied between surfaces.
- All joints where new pavement matches existing pavement shall be cut and/or ground, including driveways.
- Driveways shall be matched with a minimum one-foot apron into the driveway, whether paved or gravel.
- Contractor shall provide all vehicles and equipment along with flaggers and materials to safely complete the project.
- Contractor shall provide truck weight slips and asphalt mix design documentation to the Town.
- Contractor shall comply with Dig Safe requirements and all applicable OSHA regulations.

CONTRACTOR CONDITIONS

- Each bidder shall visit the project site and become familiar with conditions prior to submitting a bid.
- The Contractor shall furnish all necessary engineering, layout, and supervision for the project.
- The Contractor and any subcontractors shall maintain public liability insurance, automobile liability insurance, and workers' compensation coverage as required by Maine law. Certificates of insurance must be provided prior to commencement of work.
- If the total contract amount exceeds \$125,000, the successful bidder may be required to furnish Performance and Payment Bonds and or a letter of credit, each in an amount equal to 100% of the contract price, in accordance with 14 M.R.S. §871.
- Contractor shall not subcontract the project. All work shall be performed by the contractor awarded the project.

INDEMNIFICATION

The Contractor shall indemnify, defend, and hold harmless the Town of Denmark, its Selectboard members, officers, employees, agents, and volunteers from and against any and all claims, damages, losses, liabilities, judgments, penalties, fines, costs, and expenses, including reasonable attorney's fees, arising out of or resulting from the performance of the Work under this contract, provided that such claim, damage, loss, or expense is caused in whole or in part by any negligent act or omission of the Contractor, any subcontractor, anyone directly or indirectly employed by them, or anyone for whose acts they may be liable.

This obligation shall not apply to the extent that a claim is caused by the sole negligence or willful misconduct of the Town of Denmark. This indemnification provision shall survive completion of the Work and final payment.

BID SUBMISSION

Sealed bids must be received no later than Monday, April 27, 2026.

- Reject any or all bids.
- Waive informalities or minor irregularities.
- Request clarification from any bidder.
- Negotiate if deemed in the best interest of the Town.
- Modify or cancel this solicitation.
- Issue addenda or amendments.
- Award the contract to the lowest responsible and responsive bidder.

Issuance of this Request for Bids does not commit the Town to award a contract or to pay any costs incurred in preparing a bid.
