POLAND SPRING WATER EXTRACTION PERMIT RENEWAL

PUBLIC HEARING CONTINUATION RESCHEDULED

The Town of Denmark Select Board has **rescheduled the continuation of the Poland Spring Water Extraction Permit Renewal Public Hearing from September 8, 2026, to Wednesday, September 23, 2026.**

The next phase of the public hearing is intended to focus on responses to questions that have already been submitted by members of the public and the Select Board. Both the Town's Technical Agent and Poland Spring have requested additional time to adequately review and prepare responses to these questions.

Many of the questions received involve detailed and technical information. The Select Board believes that allowing additional time for the preparation of complete and meaningful responses will better serve the Board's review process and provide the public with more thorough information. **For this reason, the Board has continued the hearing to September 23, 2026.**

SEPTEMBER 8 SELECT BOARD MEETING WILL STILL BE HELD

Although the Poland Spring Public Hearing will **not** continue that evening, the regular Select Board meeting remains open to the public. During the Board's regular public comment period, members of the public may address the Board regarding the decision to extend the hearing continuation to September 23, including questions or concerns regarding the postponement.

SEPTEMBER 23 CONTINUED PUBLIC HEARING

The September 23 meeting will be a **continuation of the existing public hearing and will not reopen the hearing for new public comment or new public questions.**

The purpose of the continued hearing will be to allow **Poland Spring and the Town's Technical Agent to present responses to the public and Select Board questions already received** and to allow the Select Board to continue its review of the permit renewal application.

The Select Board appreciates the public's patience and understanding as the Town works to ensure that the questions submitted receive adequate and thorough responses.
